Zoo Hours:

Cameron Park Zoo is open daily, with the exception of Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Days.
Monday through Saturday – 9:00am until 5:00pm
Sunday – 11:00am until 5:00pm

All groups requesting the group discount rate must pre-register their group 5 business days prior to their visit. Please call (254) 750-8400 to register.

Entering the Zoo:

Please assemble your group away from the ticket booths. Have your group together and ready to enter the Zoo. The person in charge of paying for your group is the only one who needs to go to the ticket booth. Make sure you have a final count of adults and children.

*Parents accompanying school groups must pay the school in advance in order to receive the discounted admission. Otherwise they will need to pay the regular admission price.

Lunch at the Zoo:

Outside food and drinks are not allowed inside the Zoo. You may eat outside the gates and then return to the Zoo. To re-enter the Zoo after lunch, please gather your group together and present the cashier with your receipt. If you would like to order your lunch from the Zoo, you can call the Zoo Café at 254-750-8432 (you must place your order at least 5 days before your trip.) They will have your lunch ready for you at your requested time.

Parking:

Parking for buses is in the overflow parking lot – across from the main parking lot. Buses are not permitted to park in the main parking lot.

Chaperones:

One chaperone is needed for every 10 students. For pre-school students increased student/chaperone ratios are suggested. Chaperones are required to stay with and supervise students at all times.

Name Tags:

Name tags and/or shirts with the school name and teacher name are suggested, but not required. Please make sure you do not use straight pins – it presents a hazard to our animals.

Group Behavior:

Please be considerate of the animals. Do not knock on their exhibit windows, yell at them or throw objects at them. This is their home, please be respectful. Please do not feed any of the animals – they are on special diets and could get sick from other foods.
