SERVICE ANIMALS

According to the ADA, service animals are DOGS, trained to perform specific tasks for the benefit of a person with a disability.

Examples of tasks provided by service animals include guiding a person who is blind, alerting a deaf person to certain sounds or seizure or other medical alerts/ wheelchair assistance.

Animals that provide only emotional support are not service animals under the

ADA and may be denied access to public places.

Under the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices. In that case, an individual must maintain control of the animal through other effective methods.
